RESOLUTION NO. 81-1

RESOLUTION REGARDING

COOPERATION AND SUPPORT BY INTERESTED PARTIES FOR
WATER STORAGE PROJECTS THAT CREATE ADDITIONAL USABLE WATER

WHEREAS, existing water projects, many of which include storage, are beneficial. and

WHEREAS, new water projects, many of which include storage of water for future use, are proposed or nearing construction that may also be beneficial; and

WHEREAS, storage projects may have a beneficial effect on groundwater management through recharge of the aquifer; and

WHEREAS, traditional funding from federal sources generally involves a long waiting period with no monetary guarantee; and

WHEREAS, the cooperation of interested parties is necessary to obtain beneficial projects; and

WHEREAS, projects can not be built if available resources are spent opposing each project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Groundwater Management District's Association in 1981 conference assembled that the Association supports storage of water for beneficial projects; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Association urges all interested parties to work together to support and obtain funding for these beneficial projects.
