SUPPORT OF LAND APPLICATION OF MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER

WHEREAS, the proper application of municipal wastewaters to productive crop lands provides an effective, reliable, and safe treatment of municipal wastewaters; and

WHEREAS, the proper application of municipal wastewaters to productive crop lands can safely replace freshwater as a crop irrigant and recharge ground water resources; and

WHEREAS, the proper application of municipal wastewaters to productive crop lands can utilize the nutrients in wastewater that are now polluting surface and ground water resources;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the GMDA encourage and support the use of properly designed municipal wastewater treatment systems which incorporate the application of the wastewater to the land as an effective method to preserve our water resources and recharge ground water, provided such management practices and systems are consistent with all appropriate state and local laws and policies.
